In case of bad weather (ice and snow), classes at the Learning Center will be canceled IF Georgetown ISD cancels school. In the event of a "late start" bulletin from GISD, the Learning Center will open the same number of hours late. (i.e. GISD opening 2 hours late will put CLLC opening at 10:30 a.m.)

Please remember to sign-in / sign-out each day that your child attends class. Thanks for your help!

Please send your child to school in clothing that is appropriate for the weather. Warm jackets and hats are very important as we will be going outdoors. Only if it is raining or bitterly cold at the outdoor time will we be playing in the gym. Also check to make sure that the change of clothing in your child's backpack is appropriate for the current weather. Some haven't had an accident (yea!) in quite awhile, and still have warm weather clothing.

Remember tuition is due on the 1st of each month and considered late after the 10th of the month. If paid after the tenth, please include the \$25.00 late fee. Tuition envelopes will be in your child's cubby when you return on January 8, 2019.

We ask that you mark your child's new Christmas jacket, cap, and gloves with their name. Encourage your child to be observant of what he/she is wearing and of where he/she puts coats, hats, etc. These are good habits to form before your child gets into "big school."

ADDITIONAL REMINDERS

***** Pickup is at 2:00.....please do not be late. Late charges begin at 2:10 p.m. at \$1 per minute. Same for 4:00 and 4:30 pick-up. Late charges apply after ten minutes.**

***** Take home bedding each week. If your child's mat is in a pillowcase, please help your child's teacher by slipping it on the mat when you return the clean bedding on Tuesday.**

***** If you must pickup your child early from school, please drop by the office first and tell Mrs. Peters or Mrs. Makar. One of them will then go to the classroom and inform the teacher. This is especially important during nap time to not disturb the other children.**

Parents: With all the coughs and colds going around at this time of the year, we need to make sure our children are well before coming back to school. This is not only for the well-being of the other children, but for your child also. Please consult the **HEALTH POLICY STATEMENT** that is in the Parent Handbook (each family received one at the beginning of the school year) if you have any questions or concerns about our policies. If your child has any of the symptoms listed, please keep your child at home until these symptoms disappear or until your physician determines that your child can return to school without spreading an infection to others.
