VALENTINE PARTIES - It's time for XOXOXO's! Parties will begin at 8:45 on Thursday, February 14. Party parents should be in contact with their child's teacher to find out the schedule for that day. Each child should bring valentine cards to exchange with his/her classmates. (A list of the children in each class is included in this newsletter.) As you address the valentines, we ask that the names of the children be printed using upper case for only the first letter. This is an excellent opportunity for the children to practice name recognition. The Fours may want to address their own cards.

LEARNING CENTER POST OFFICE

Beginning February 1, the Learning Center will be operating a post office, and we encourage the parents to be part of the fun! Our post office will be open through Wed., February 13. When you "mail" a note to your child, please drop it in the cardboard mailbox in the entry by the elevator. The mail will be sorted and delivered by post office crew. Need the address? Check in your child's cubby for the roster that was sent home.

2019 - 2020 Registration

Registration forms for the 2019 - 2020 school year will be sent home with your child soon. Families who currently have a child in the Learning Center (along with church members) will be given first priority to register during February. After that, it will be opened to the public on a first come, first serve basis. Please remember ALL children registering for a three year old class must be completely potty trained. If you have any questions about our upcoming registration, please come by the school office.

PARENT – TEACHER CONFERENCES

Opportunities for parent-teacher conferences will be made available in March, April, and May. Sign-up sheets will be posted outside the classroom at a later date. Conferences will be held during class time as arrangements will be made for a substitute in the classroom.

If you have an immediate concern, please feel free to contact your child's teacher via phone, email, or text as she will be happy to visit with you. Please remember that it is NOT convenient for teachers to visit about your child at drop-off or pick-up time as they are trying to engage all the children at these times. Thank you!

SUMMER KIDZ KAMP sessions will be available around March 1.

CLLC is having a summer Kidz Kamp again this year. We hope to have TEN sessions during the months of June, July and August. This Kidz Kamp is open to children ages 2 to 5 years old (may not have attended kindergarten), as long as the child is two by March 1, 2019 (or is currently attending CLLC). We are offering two different time options to accommodate the needs of more families. Children can attend either 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. (pickup before lunch and nap) or from 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. (for those that need longer childcare). Cost is either \$80 a session for shorter hours or \$150 per session for extended hours. Tuition is non-refundable and payable at time of registration. You may choose as many or few sessions as you would like! Class size is limited, so please register early!

Session 1: Monday – Thursday, June 3-6

Session 2: Monday – Thursday, June 10-13

Session 3: Monday – Thursday, June 17-20

Session 4: Monday – Thursday, June 24-27

NO CAMP - July 1-4

Session 5: Monday – Thursday, July 8-11

Session 6: Monday – Wednesday, July 15-17 (3 days only)

Session 7: Monday – Thursday, July 22-25

Session 8: Monday – Thursday, July 29-August 1

Session 9: Monday - Thursday, August 5-8

Session 10: Monday - Thursday, August 12-15

Classes will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. There will be no drop-ins allowed. There must be a minimum of five children enrolled per session for the class to make.

Session 6 will be 3 days only so the CLLC staff are available to attend their annual training required by the Department of Family and Protective Services which begins on Thursday, July 18, 2019.

Parents: please remember....weather permitting, we will spend some part of the day outside as this is extremely important for the development of the body and mind. Please make sure your child has appropriate clothing, including hats and gloves. (PLEASE LABEL!)
